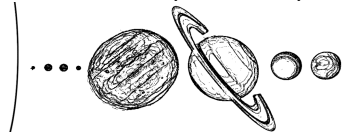

Week 5: June 22-June 26

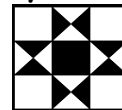


Aesop's Fables, Nursery Rhymes, and More!

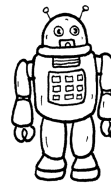

We'll spend time tinkering, creating unique inventions out of old items and marvel at the mighty wonder of God's Creation.



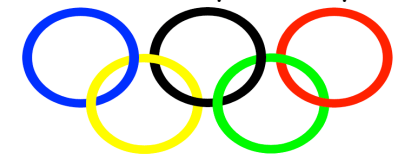
Week 9: July 20-July 24
